ERASMUS+ STAFF MOBILITY FOR TEACHING (AY 2023/24)

The main principles of Erasmus+ staff mobility for teaching:

- The duration of the mobility is from 2 to 5 days (excluding travel time). Extra 1-2 days for travelling;
- a teaching activity has to comprise a minimum of 8 hours of teaching per week (or any shorter period of stay);
- You may select the receiving institution from the list or VU Partner universities;
- Participants will receive their regular Vilnius University salaries while away on Erasmus+ visit.

HOW TO START IF YOU WISH TO GO ON ERASMUS+ TEACHING MOBILITY?

- 1. You select a receiving institution from among <u>VU Erasmus+ partner institutions</u>.
- 2. Fill in the Application Form and submit it. The application deadline: 10 October 20223.
- 3. After the application deadline Erasmus+ faculty coordinator makes a priority list of selected staff and sends it to Institutional Erasmus+ coordinator at the International Relations Office.
- 4. Applicants will be notified about the application decisions within 2-3 weeks after the deadline.
- 5. The priority is given to academic staff who: 1) gives lectures in foreign languages, 2) his/her course is integrated into the study program of the receiving university, 3) visit contributes to the cooperation between the receiving university and Vilnius University in general or a respective faculty in particular.
- 6. If your application is accepted, please prepare the **teaching programme**: 1) explain the objectives of the mobility, 2) the added value of the mobility for both institutions and 3) the expected results. The teaching programme must be agreed on and signed by all three parties.
